

Pensions Dashboard: Alpha 1 Prototype

Project Context

What is the context around the project?

Following the OIX alpha project completed in May 2016 the Association of British Insurers is leading an initiative across the UK pensions industry to define the open data standards and governance structures that will enable pension dashboards to develop and operate. The open data standards and governance structures will need to be tested through one or more prototypes to ensure that they are practical and can be delivered operationally.

Many organisations are likely to develop pension dashboard prototypes. They will not wish to share their internal design approaches with their competitors. However, there will be value in working openly to test open standards against dashboards, in particular those that relate to security and authentication, identity verification, and the customer's identity data that will be used for matching against pension accounts.

Project Hypothesis

What is the hypothesis to be tested by the project? (Repeat on front page)

Digital identities that have been certified against government standards through an accredited identity scheme will provide the necessary assurance of identity to Pension Providers to enable matching against back end pension accounts and presentation of the pensions data in a pension dashboard.

Project Objectives

To design the interface and user journey between the Pensions Dashboard and the accredited identity scheme so that the user can make a trustworthy assertion of identity. Focus on identity and security from both a technical and trust framework perspective.
